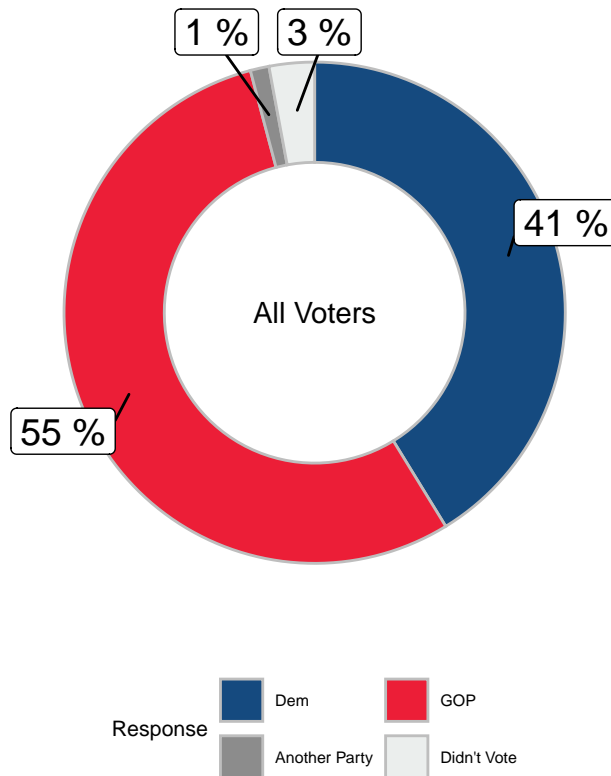
Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from Wednesday, March 13th to Wednesday, March 13th, 2024, among a sample of 818 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in Ohio. The survey was conducted using text message recruitment and IVR to complete the survey. Since the text messages were sent to random registered Ohio voters the poll can be assigned a margin of error. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in Ohio.

The margin of error for the poll is +/- 3.4% at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample.

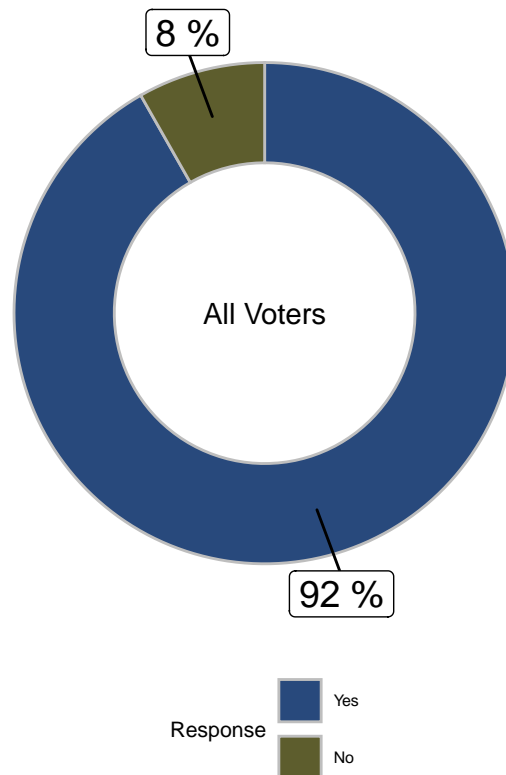

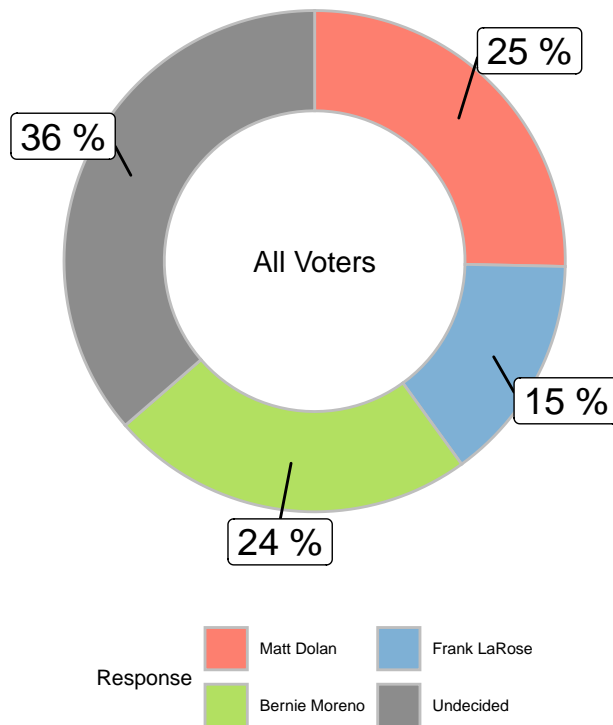

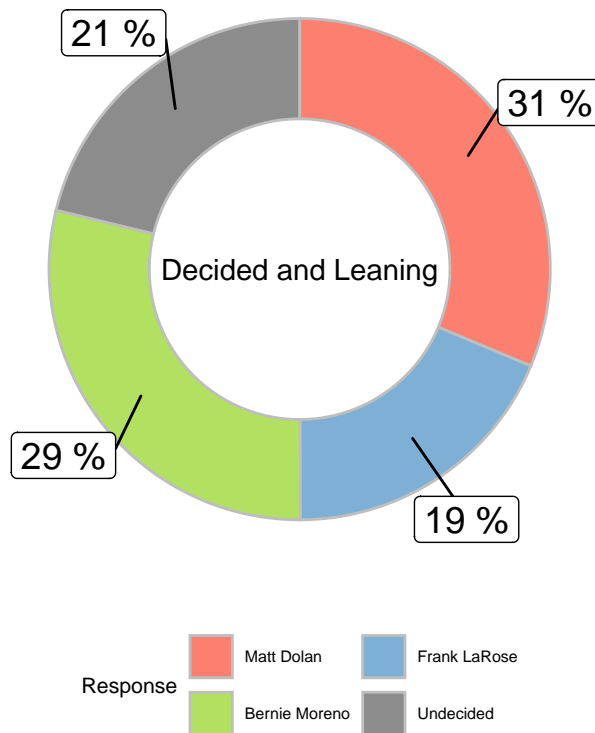

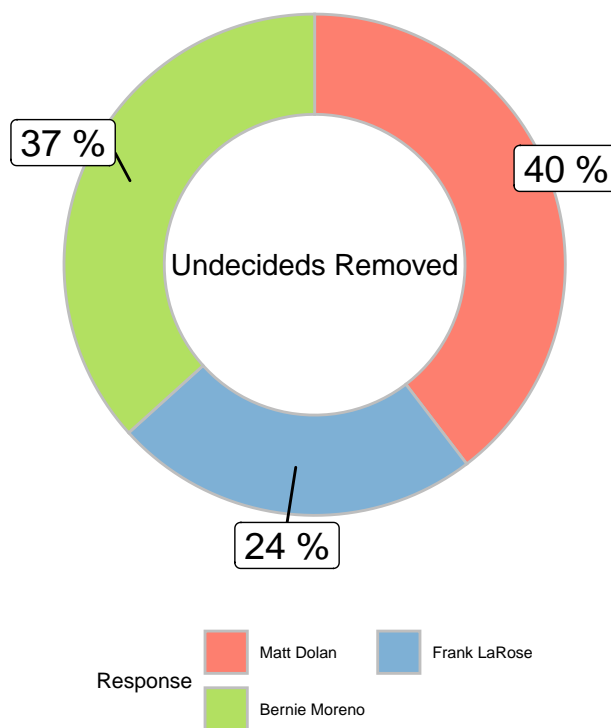

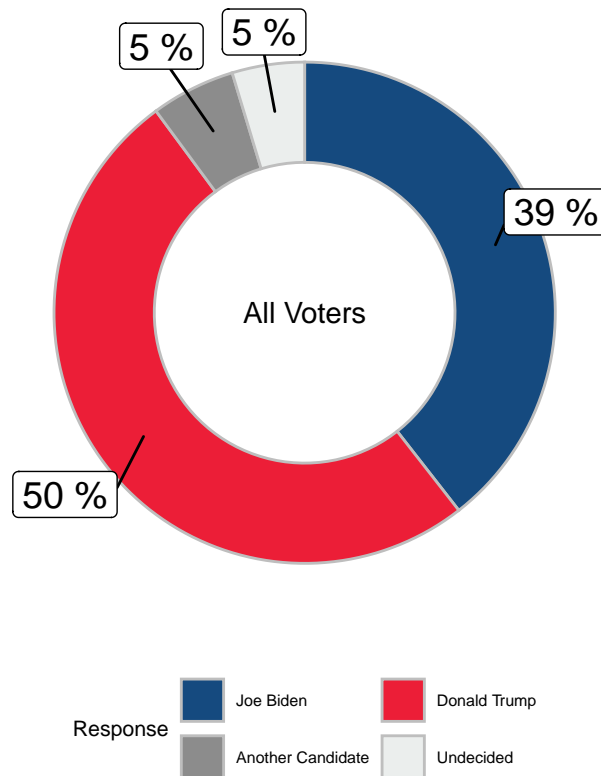

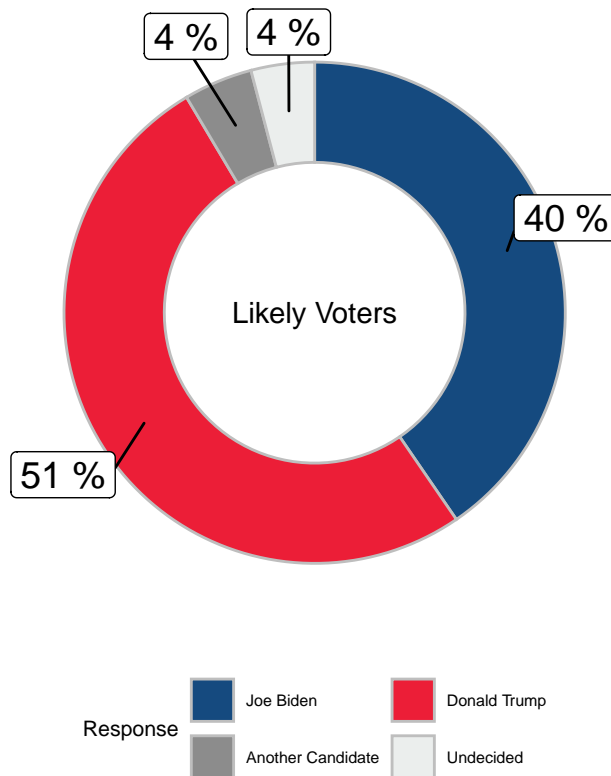

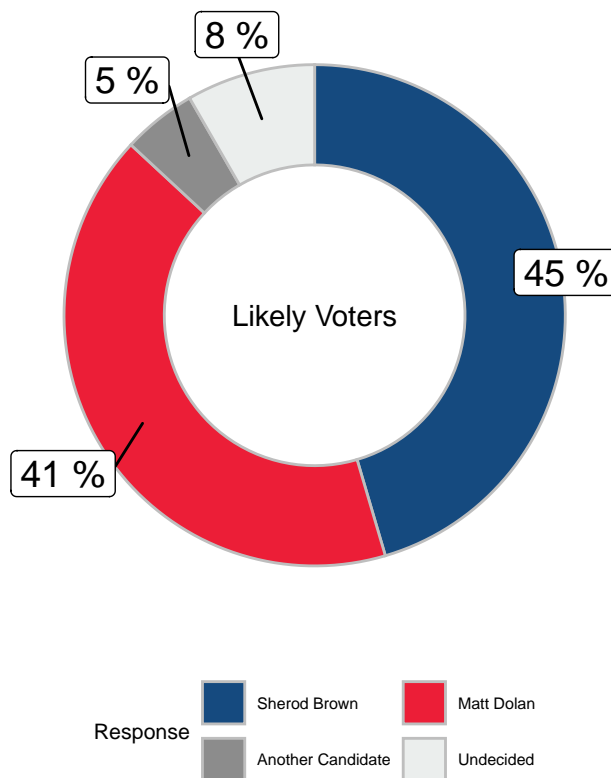

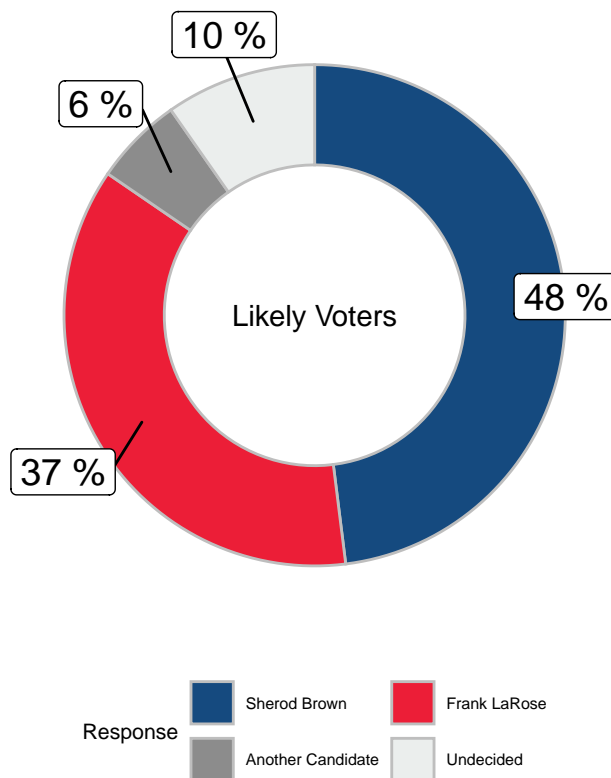
