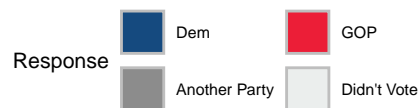
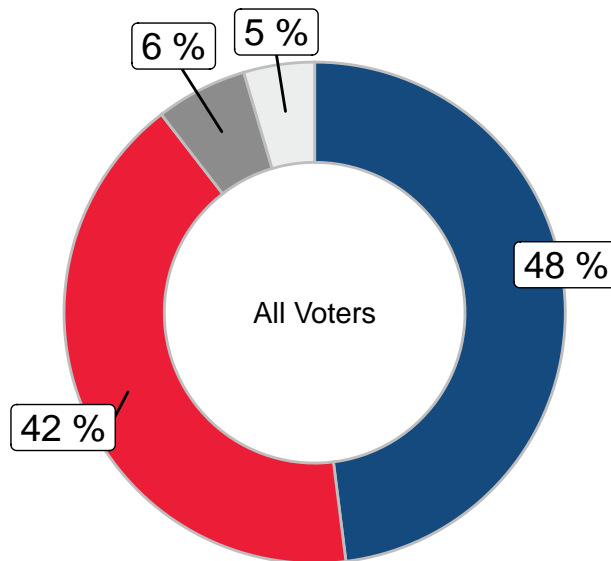
Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from Thursday, February 29th to Sunday, March 3rd, 2024, among a sample of 3502 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in Super Tuesday States. The survey was conducted using text message recruitment and IVR to complete the survey. Since the text messages were sent to random registered Super Tuesday States voters the poll can be assigned a margin of error. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in Super Tuesday States.

The margin of error for the poll is +/- 1.7% at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample.

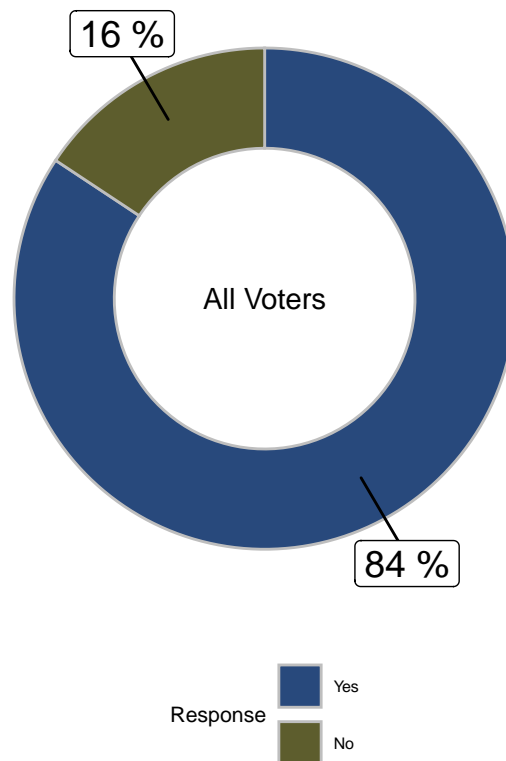

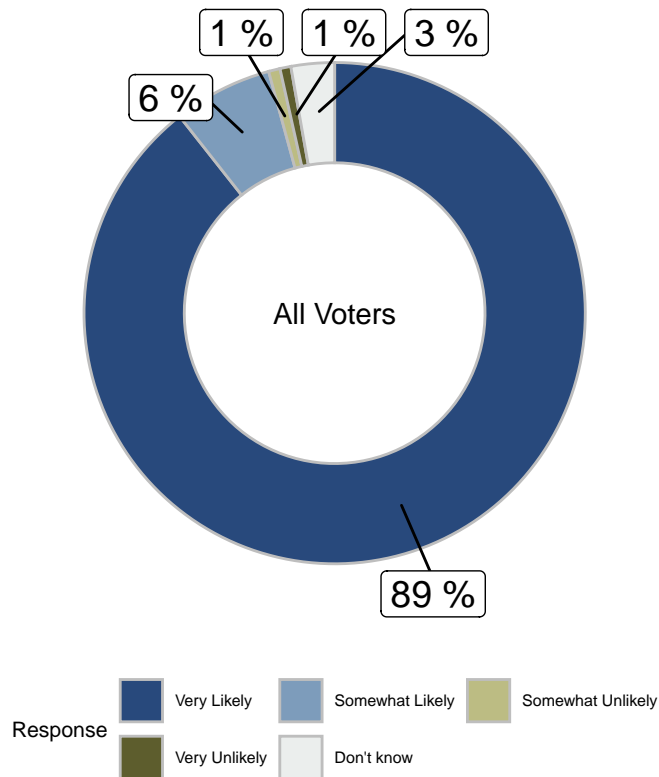

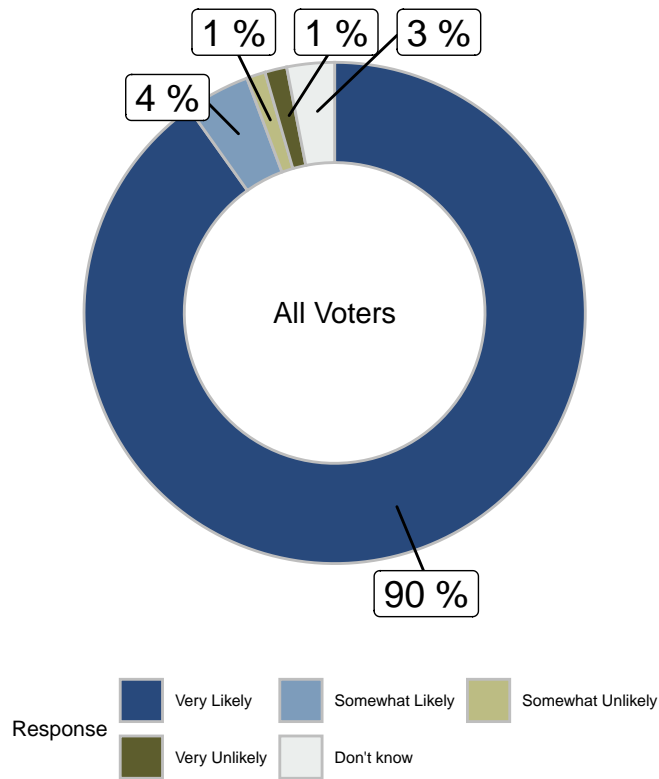
