
Methodology

The analysis in this report is based on results of a survey conducted from Friday, March 15th to Sunday, March 17th, 2024, among a sample of 1053 adults, 18 years of age or older, living in The United States. The survey was conducted using text message recruitment and IVR to complete the survey. Since the text messages were sent to random registered The United States voters the poll can be assigned a margin of error. The survey is intended to represent the voting population in The United States.

The margin of error for the poll is +/- 3% at the 95% confidence level. Margins of error are higher in each subsample.

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In the most recent Presidential election (November 2020) which party did you vote for in the Presidential election? (all voters)





If the election for President were held today, and the candidates were Joe Biden and Donald Trump, which candidate would you support? (all voters)







What is the main reason you would not vote for Joe Biden, or would you consider voting for him? (Non-Biden voters)





What is the main reason you would not vote for Donald Trump, or would you consider voting for him? (Non-Trump voters)





If the election for the House of Representatives was held today, which party would you vote for? (all voters)





If the election for the House of Representatives was held today, which party would you vote for? (likely voters)





Do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling his job as President? (all voters)





Did the most recent State of the Union Speech by Joe Biden change your view of his fitness for the office of President of the United States? (all voters)




